Signing an agreement on the reuse of treated water produced by Treatment Plant for agriculture in Nablus West.

Agreement on a project for the reuse of treated water produced by WWTP for irrigation of agricultural products has bee signed by Nablus Municipality, the Ministry of Finance and the Palestinian Water Authority aims at improving the agricultural sector of Nablus. This project will contribute in replanting and irrigating of about three thousand hectares of agricultural land and will improve yields and thus the living conditions of the farmers.

Nablus Municipality participated in the first Palestinian International Water Forum



Nablus Municipality participated in the first international Water Forum on modern techniques for the implementation of sustainable water resources' management. As twenty countries attended the Forum international expertise concerning the fields of water, environment and climate change has been exchanged. The major topic shed the light on the sustainable availability and management of water and sanitation for everybody.

Nablus Municipality and the World Bank discussed possible implementation of several strategic projects in Nablus



The representatives of the World Bank expressed their intention to invest in strategic projects in Nablus in form of grants and loans. However, Municipality has to develop its financial and administrative systems continuously. Both sides concluded to study some project proposals jointly and discuss the financing subsequently.

Memorandum of Understanding signed between Nablus Municipality and the Palestinian National Center for Agricultural

Research

An MOU on the reuse of treated water and sal Mouse as fertilizer in agriculture was signed between Nablus Municipality and the Palestinian National Center for Agricultural Research. The West water treatment plant of Nablus Municipality is ready to carry out research on the reuse of treated water, and positive future impacts in agriculture are expected thereby.

Nablus Municipality received a high-level Turkish delegation



Nablus Municipality welcomed a high level Turkish Delegation to review several projects in Nablus that are funded by the TIKA, i.e. a school and the restoration of some historic landmarks. The Turkish delegation visited Nablus in occasion of organizing an orphan group Iflar in Ramadan, of which has been attended by representatives of charitable organizations in Nablus.

Nablus Municipality launches unit of solar power generation in the wastewater treatment plant



Attended by Nurnberg official delegation, Nablus Municipality inaugurated a unit of solar power generation in the western wastewater treatment plant, which represents a milestone on the transition to renewable energies. The pilot project sponsored by Nurnberg Municipality, and aims to test the possibility of linking electricity cables, a methane and a solar unit in one purification plant. The solar unit will produce 125 kWh, which provides 10-12% of the electric power needed by the treatment plant and will be used to pump up wa-

ter for irrigating crops. The Energy Authority expressed its willingness to support and invest more in projects in Nablus. Moreover this project is the first step of a technical cooperation between Nablus and Nuremberg.

A delegation of Nablus -Nurnberg Association visited Nablus

Nablus Municipality received a delegation of the Nablus-Nurnberg Association for the first time. During their week visit, they visited various institutions and were briefed on the current political situation of Palestinian people. During several meetings, it was agreed upon to cooperate and exchange in areas like culture, arts, tourism and women issues. The delegation pledged that two fire engines are donated by the Nuremberg Municipality and expected to arrive soon.

Nablus Municipality receives the new Director of the German Development Bank

Nablus Municipality received the new Director of the German Development Bank, Ms. Anna Volck, to review the progress of projects funded by the German Government, and listened to the challenges in the sewage sector, thanking the former Director for his efforts.
