Nablus Municipality met representatives of MEDINA Foundation from Province of Tuscany in Italy 31-5-2017

Wastewater Management Nablus East Project



In the farm work of Wastewater Management Nablus East Project, Nablus Municipality has awarded so far two contracts. The budget allocation of this project was financed from the German Government through KfW-BMZ with total amount of Euro 17,142,857.14.

The Project concerns the improvement of the wastewater management in Nablus East and surrounding six villages as well as a pilot project in the region of Nablus for the reuse of treated wastewater. The purpose of the Project is to improve the wastewater management in the project region. This is to contribute to the achievement of national sector objectives for

Nablus Municipality received experts in the field of solar energy from the city of Nurnberg/ Germany 08/07/2017

In continuous effort to complete the solar energy project, being implemented at the Western wastewater treatment plant, with the support of the German municipality of Nurnberg, Mayor Adly Yaish received a delegation from the said German city, represented by the international relations officer and experts in the field of solar energy. A workshop was held with the participation of a number of

technicians and specialists from Palestinian municipalities and consulting companies working in this area.

With the participation of German experts, Nablus Municipality & GIZ held a two days workshop on Solar Energy 10/7/2017

Mayor Adly Yaish opened the workshop by welcoming the participants, expressed his gratitude for the tremendous efforts of German government to improve the water and waste water sector in Nablus. The workshop was held in cooperation GIZ and extended for two consecutive days, led by German experts and technicians from the city of Nurnberg, with the participation of representatives from a number Palestinian municipalities, in addition to a group of companies specializing in the generation of electric power.



Cooperation agreement with the German Global engagement community. 27-5-2017 Mayor Yaish and Mr. Rami Masri a representative of Nuremberg Municipality, signed a new cooperative agreement entails implementing a pilot project for generating power by solar energy panels



in the West Treatment Plant, funded by the German government through Nuremberg municipality in Germany. The project is being implemented at the Waste Water Treatment Plant—Nablus West, with a total fund allocation of 250,000 Euros. The project is currently being implemented under the follow up and supervision of German technical experts who arrived to Nablus for this purpose.
